POLICIES AND GUIDELINES

PURPOSE

In 2014, the Plymouth City Council approved the installation of a Veterans Memorial within the Hilde Performance Center. The Veterans Memorial has been established as a place to remember and honor those individuals who have served our country in the United States Armed Forces. The purpose of this policy is to create a set of guidelines for the names being engraved.

GUIDELINES

All veterans are welcome to be included on the Veterans Memorial Wall within the Hilde Performance Center pursuant to the guidelines below.



- Veterans do not need to reside in Plymouth, MN to be included in this memorial.
- The Veteran named must hold an honorable discharge or a discharge under honorable conditions such as medical, family emergency, etc.
- Completed applications must be submitted with official proof of service (e.g. Original or Certified DD Form 214) and payment. Visit www.archives.gov/veterans/military-service-records for a printable proof of service form or to download a SF180 form to request proof directly from the National Archives. **Photocopies of the original or certified documents are unable to be accepted.**
- The Veteran listed must have served in the U.S. military.
- Veterans may have served in wartime or peacetime, been full service or a reserve, may be deceased or living.
- Requests should be submitted to the City of Plymouth Park & Recreation Department. Verification and final approvals will be provided by the Beyond the Yellow Ribbon Committee.
- Engraving will be done once each year at a designated time.
- The wall has room to recognize up to 1,300 Service Members.
- Name placement on the wall will be determined by the City.

PROCESS

The City of Plymouth will engrave the name and branch of any Veteran who complies with the guidelines listed above. In order to be included, an application must be completed and submitted with a fee of \$175.
