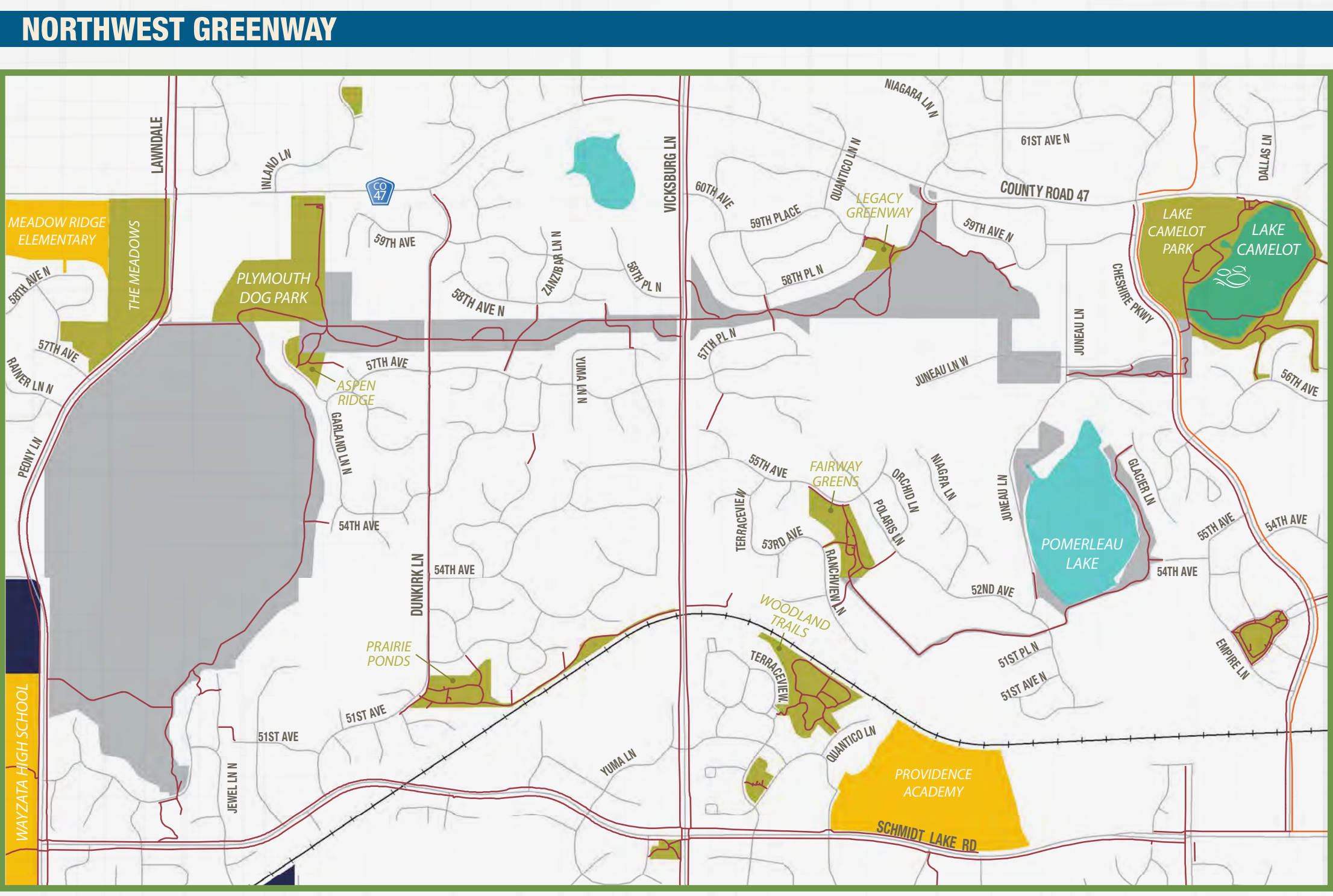

The Northwest Greenway (NWG) is a 350-acre wooded nature preserve with winding bike and pedestrian trails that span northwest Plymouth from Peony Lane (near Wayzata High School) to Cheshire Parkway (near Lake Camelot Park). NWG amenities include 7 miles of looping paved trails, benches, bicycle fix-it stations, drinking fountains, restrooms and more. The NWG connects to 10 neighborhoods and a number of parks, including Aspen Ridge Park, Legacy Greenway Park, Lake Camelot Park and the Plymouth Dog Park. In addition, the NWG connects to Medicine Lake Regional Trail, which links to French and Elm Creek regional parks. Additional phases of development will add 2-3 miles of trail, two trailhead/park facilities on Peony Lane, and trail connections to Fairway Greens Park, Prairie Ponds Park and Lake Pomerleau. The Northwest Greenway preserves a large amount of Plymouth's natural space and offers residents greater opportunity to enjoy the outdoors.

PARK REGULATIONS

- Park hours are 6:00 am-10:00 pm, except community playfields which close at 10:30 pm. Hours are posted in each park.
- Pets are allowed if leashed/under restraint by owner & with means to pick up waste. The Plymouth Dog park, Happy Tails, and 4 Paws are off-leash parks.
- Alcohol and/or Tobacco use is not allowed in any park or on facility property.
- The following activities are prohibited in city parks and open spaces:
 - Driving/Parking on grass or park trails
 - Offering/Conducting a business sale or service
 - Cutting/Injuring trees or other natural growth
 - Open fires except in a metal grill
 - Swimming when the beach is posted as closed
- Camping, Hunting or Trapping
- Firearms, Fireworks or Model Rockets

TRAIL GUIDELINES

Trails are shared by walkers, runners, skaters and bicyclists. Please be courteous and observe these guidelines when using the trails.

- Keep your speed at a reasonable and prudent level for the conditions. Watch for slower trail users and yield to them.
- Motorized recreational vehicles are not allowed on trails.
- Travel on the right side of the trail. If traveling in groups, allow space for other trail users to pass by safely.
- Keep pets leashed/restrained at all times.
- When passing, pass on the left. Please announce loudly, "on your left" proceed with caution and slowed speed.
- When stopping, move to the right and step off the trail.
- Be aware that trail surfaces may be slippery if wet or covered in leaves, snow or ice.
- Stop at road crossings and look for cars before proceeding.

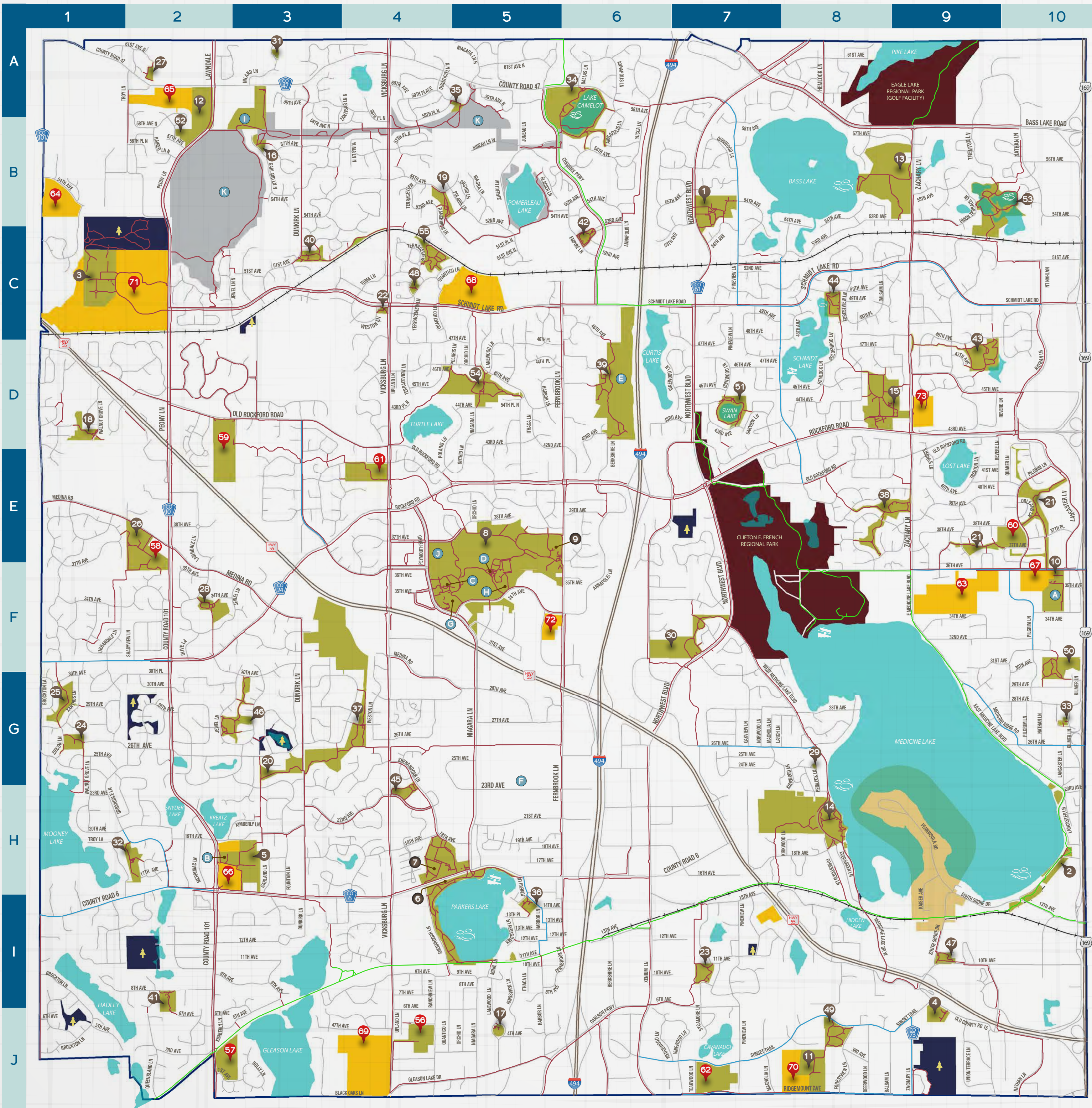
