Dear Property Owner:

In partnership with Minnehaha Creek Watershed District (MCWD), the City of Plymouth is implementing a stream restoration project in Maple Creek Park located near your home. This project will help address downstream flooding, improve the City's ability to maintain drainage, and improve water quality upstream of Gleason Lake.

This project will involve cleaning portions of the creek, repairing damaged storm sewer infrastructure, and constructing water quality improvements along Maple Creek. More information about the project can be found online on the City of Plymouth and MCWD websites:

Construction and tree removals started in mid-February, however due to warmer weather the project will be delayed until winter 2022-2023. The contractor will be on site within the next couple weeks to clean up tree debris and re-establish disturbed grasses. It is anticipated the project will resume in November 2022 and will be completed by early spring 2023.

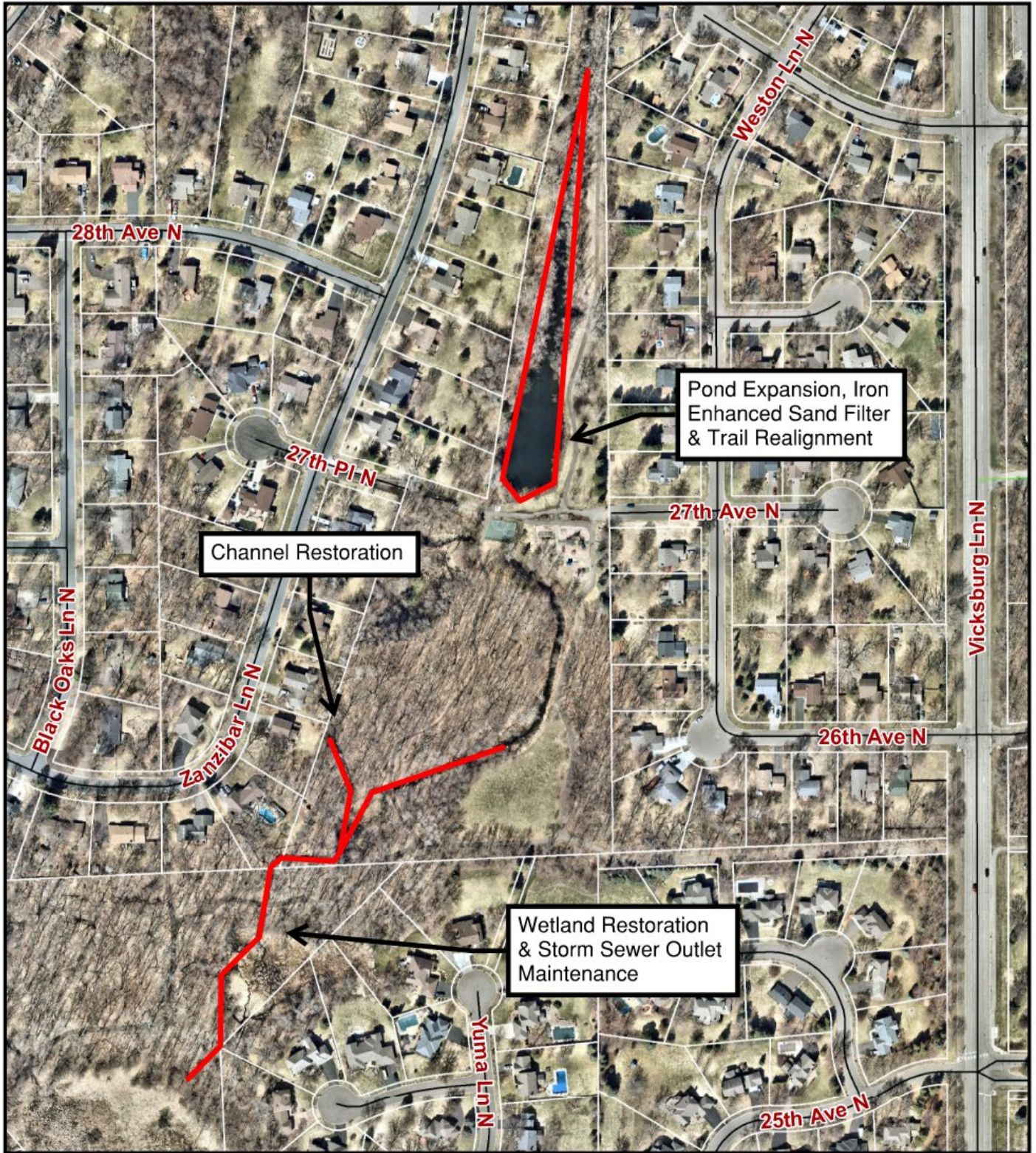
