History of Plymouth

The first people to live in Plymouth were the Dakota Indians. They set up camp on the north end of Medicine Lake.

The first settler was Antoine LeCounte. He arrived in 1848. He was a guide and explorer. He carried mail and traded goods to Native Americans for horses. He built the first log cabin.

Plymouth became a town in 1855. The town was located on the northwest shores of what is now Parkers Lake.

Most of the settlers in Plymouth were farmers. It didn't take long before schools, churches and a post office was built. Then hotels and roads were built. Many people came to vacation at beautiful Medicine Lake.

There are more than 70,000 people living in Plymouth today.
