This letter is to inform you that a street adjacent to your property has been identified as a candidate for improvement in 2023. A map of the proposed project area can be found on the back of this letter.


In preparation for this project, you may notice crews in your area marking curb for removal, collecting pavement samples, reviewing utilities, and gathering other information for the project. This is necessary to develop the project scope, and once we have collected the necessary information, we will send out another letter inviting you to a public meeting for the project. This meeting is anticipated to be held this winter and will include information about what the rehabilitation process involves, special assessments associated with the project, and staff will be available to answer any questions you may have.

Of course, recognizing the businesses, school, multi-family housing complexes, and Community Center along the project area, careful consideration of access will be made during the project development process and presented at the public meeting. Opportunities for coordination of property-specific considerations will be available at the public meeting or by contacting the project manager in advance.
