PROJECT SCHEDULE

A construction schedule has been provided by the city's contractor, Asphalt Surface Technologies. A phasing map and expected timeline can be viewed on page two. The schedule is anticipated but may change due to weather or other factors. The following is an overview of the construction phases:

Week of May 22nd

- A new asphalt trail will be paved in Phase 1A earlier in the week.
- Milling work will take place in Phase 1A and the final layer of asphalt pavement will be installed by the end of the week.
- The roadway will remain open to traffic throughout Phase 1A, but delays should be anticipated as the road may be reduced to one lane.

Week of May 29th

- No work will occur on Monday, May 29th due to the Memorial Day holiday.
- Construction in Phase 1B will begin on 34th
 Avenue, west of the Plymouth Community Center, with spot curb removals and reclaiming (grinding up) the existing street pavement.
- Access to the Plymouth Community Center and residences will remain open during Phase 1B.

June

- Water main valve repairs will occur in Phase 1B.
- Concrete sidewalk and curb replacement will begin in Phase 1B.
- Asphalt pavement will be installed in Phase 1B.
- Construction in Phase 2A (34th Avenue/35th Avenue loop) is scheduled to begin in late June.
