The City of Plymouth is proposing to implement a drainage improvement project within your neighborhood, as shown in the enclosed map. This pond located at the 19th Avenue North and Dunkirk Lane intersection has been identified as needing maintenance to remove accumulated sediment and repair stormwater structures. This project is being designed to protect water quality and improve the drainage system.
