## PROJECT SCHEDULE

A construction schedule has been provided by the city's contractor, Asphalt Surface Technologies. A phasing map and expected timeline can be viewed on page two. The schedule is anticipated but may change due to weather or other factors. The following is an overview of the construction phases:

#### Week of July 17th

- The final layer of asphalt will be paved on 34<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 35<sup>th</sup> Avenue in Phase 2A.
- Work will begin on Phase 2B (36<sup>th</sup> Avenue) on Wednesday, July 19<sup>th</sup> with pavement removals and on 2C (37<sup>th</sup> Avenue) later in the week with pavement removal preparation.
- The roadway will generally remain open to traffic throughout Phases 2B and 2C, but delays should be anticipated as the road may be reduced to one lane. There will also be times when traffic won't be able to get through 36<sup>th</sup> Ave from Vicksburg Ln to Plymouth Blvd because of utility work, but at least one driveway access to all businesses and residences will remain open throughout construction.

#### Week of July 24th

- Pavement removals will continue on 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue and will begin on 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
- Utility work will begin on 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue with water valve repairs and storm sewer installation.

#### **August**

- Utility work will begin on 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
- Spot curb and sidewalk replacements will begin in Phases 2B and 2C.
- The top of the existing pavement will be milled off on 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue and the final layer of asphalt pavement will be installed.
- The existing pavement on 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue will be reclaimed (ground up and turned to gravel) and the first layer of asphalt pavement will be installed.
