#### Club Groups

Lite rides are on Wednesdays, only. Regular rides are on Monday and/or Wednesday. The Monday ride may be more exploratory, checking for trail closures and alternate routes. The Monday ride will have the same start time and location as the Wednesday ride. Club member may choose the Lite or Regular ride that fits their ability and interest. Note that the "Ride Cancellation Info Line" will be available for Monday and both Wednesday rides.

#### Ride Cancellation Info Line

Our announcement line is 763-509-5275. On ride days, the announcement will be updated by 7:30 a.m. only if the ride is cancelled. Call the info line if in doubt so you don't drive to a ride and find out that it was cancelled.

### Start Times

All rides on the 4th schedules start at 9:30, except 10:00 for the Lites' ride on September 25 and the Regulars' rides on September 30 and October 2.
