## Review and Approval Process

Return the completed application packet to the City Clerk.

The application will be referred to the Building Division for an inspection. A recommendation will be submitted to the City Manager for approval or denial. Upon approval of the application, a license will be issued by the City Clerk. If the application is denied, an appeal can be made within ten (10) days to be considered by the City Council.
